Bookmarks and a whole lot more!

# What is it?

- You can **create** bookmarks with it and **share** them
- Plus, you can **highlight** text
- And, you can **add notes**
- Finally, you can **share the updated web page**

# Share your bookmarks/annotations

- Send by **email** a **bookmark** or list (folder) of bookmarks
- Share a **link of a bookmark or a list** with your updated, highlighted, commented bookmarks
- **New!** Using a **list** of your annotated bookmarks, generate "**webslides**", a "slideshow" of your bookmarks, with a unique link to share it with

# Where do you start?

1. Go to diigo.com or [diigo.com/tools](https://diigo.com/tools)
2. Click on **diigolet**
3. **Drag** the diigolet to your web browser tool bar
4. **Sign up for Diigo**, and start collecting bookmarks
5. Later-add a **Diigo [toolbar](#)**

# How do I?

- Add a [bookmark](#), Add [highlighting](#)
- Add [sticky notes](#),
- Use [Chrome](#) (web browser) to capture part of a web page, add rectangles/arrows, and save it as an image (Free from [Chrome Web Store](#))

# What can you import?

**Update:** Can [export Google bookmarks](#) and import into Diigo

Use Diigo toolbar installed on Internet Explorer/Firefox to [import](#) bookmarks

[Import](#) from and/or Save bookmarks to delicious bookmarks tool
