#### Rationale

From UNC-Charlotte's *Report to the Provost from the LMS Evaluation Committee* (May 2009):

Like all electronic technologies, LMSs are constantly evolving. This evolution imposes the need for continuous evaluation, consideration of alternatives, and appraisal of the resources and opportunities currently available. Intelligent transitioning has become a staple of the efficient use of instructional technology, and much depends upon flexibility and control over the timing and direction of such choices.
