


Diigo How do you say it?: Dee'go

What is it?

- [Online bookmarking](#) (web site links are available anywhere); share with others
- [Highlight text](#) on a web page you've saved
- Add a comment to a block of text or add a sticky note to the web page; save with a web page
- Take a "snapshot" of part or all of a web page (saved as html or screenshot/pic)
 - You can add text, arrows, circles and rectangles to your snapshot
- The example below is a web page snapshot that had a bit of red bold text and a comment (the number 1 in a box) next to yellow highlighted text
 - In the snapshot, I added in blue text "Add text to a screen shot", a blue arrow, plus a purple rectangle

(3) **Snapshot (New!):** Check this, this web page will be uploaded and captured as a snapshot in both HTML and screenshot (pic) formats. [Add text to a screenshot](#)

Tips:

- Archiving dynamic web pages and multiple versions of the same URL, ie. snapshots of the moment in time, make bookmarking so much more useful. For example, you can archive your stock portfolio periodically, so you can easily see how it evolves over time.
-  Besides webpages, if you can also archive other document types that are already posted online, such as a PDF with URL, or an online Word doc (archivable under Diigo's IE toolbar)
- Diigo V4 enables you to search your entire Library, including archived items

How do you get it? from diigo.com

- Install the Toolbar or add the diigolet (bookmarklet) to your browser

How is it like other bookmarking tools?

- You can associate tags with your bookmarks (to use to search for later)
- You can create lists of bookmarks that you want to group together, like a list of bookmarks called "Web 2.0 Tips"
- You can share your bookmarks with other people
- You can "follow" people

How is it different from other bookmarking tools?

- You can import and/or synchronize all your bookmarks with delicious bookmarks
- You can highlight, comment and take snapshots of web sites

What web services does it have?

- Import/export bookmarks and send bookmarks to a blog
