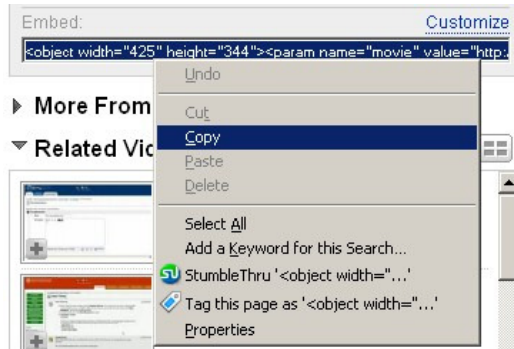


Embedding YouTube Videos in Blackboard

YouTube

1. Visit: www.youtube.com
2. Search for a video
3. Copy the embed code (in a box to the right of the video)



Blackboard

Go to the Control Panel and find the content area where you want to embed your video. You can also create a new content area to add videos.

1. Click on Add Item
